## Payments

- Registration closes Tuesday, June 1, 2010.
- A waiting list will be started June 1.
- Full payment for tuition and fees must be sent by June 1 to avoid a late fee (£30).
- Late payments and payments for optional items will be accepted until June 13 or 1 week prior to the deadline set by the Conference Centre.

All payments are in pounds sterling, £, (Great Britain Pounds, GBP). Currency conversion rates vary according to location and date. One currency converter can be found at [xe.com](http://xe.com).

- Your deposit must be paid to reserve a place for you in Cwrs Cymru Deg / Beautiful Wales Course 2010.

- Deposit refund policy (other than for scholarship applicants)
  - Deposits will be refunded in full upon request prior to May 1.
  - For deposits made online (only), the deposit will be refunded in full upon request made up to 58 days after the deposit was made.
  - 50% of the deposit will be refunded upon request between May 1 and June 1.
  - After June 1, requests for a return of the deposit will be handled on a case-by-case basis. We cannot guarantee more than a 50% refund of the deposit after June 1.
